### **FUTURE OF RESEARCH**

#### What is Future of Research?

- Nationwide nonprofit that champions, engages, empowers, early career researchers (ECRs) with evidence-based resources to improve the scientific research endeavor.
- A volunteer-run nonprofit that promotes grassroots advocacy among early career and seeks to empower the voice of ECRs.
- Also seeks to empower early career researchers by organizing workshops and collecting data about academia and scientific training, and make that data available to help make rational decisions with regards to career paths and advocacy efforts

#### What is the focus of FoR?

- Mentoring Future Scientists: A project currently revising and disseminating guidelines for institutional training environments, as well as collecting data based on their implementation
- International Scholars Task Force: Project focusing on surveying, identifying, analyzing, and reporting on the unique challenges faced by the international scholar community in the U.S.
- <u>Policy Task Force</u> The Policy Task Force stays up to date on governmental and institutional policies that arise and affect ECRs, and draft responses to RFI's that affect

#### ECRs.

 Labor Task Force: Project focusing on institutional and departmental policies that affect the labor of ECRs. They are currently surveying and collecting data on unionization efforts for postdocs and graduate students, and on postdoctoral scholars who lose their benefits by accepting national training awards.


